# Demand for Cloud, Mobile and SharePoint Growing

A survey of CIOs and IT directors shows that the sharp increase in cloud and mobile platforms is changing how people collaborate in the workplace, and presenting new challenges to corporate IT departments.


Although desktop email remains the preferred collaboration tool for 71% of workers, 87% of survey respondents generally and 92% of organizations with 3,000 or more employees have deployed SharePoint. While 53% indicated that SharePoint is helping their employees collaborate with colleagues, clients and suppliers, many respondents also expressed concerns about it. For example, 64% of respondents in the financial sector reported that SharePoint requires a high level of customization. SharePoint's limited reporting and analytics features were another sticking point for senior IT management, as was its poor user interface.

In addition to SharePoint, 54% of survey respondents indicated that they have already granted business users access to corporate documents via mobiles or tablets, or plan to within the next 12 months. Managing these new mobile collaboration tools presents a significant challenge for IT teams tasked with safe-guarding corporate documents and systems.


92% of organizations with 3,000 or more employees have deployed SharePoint



What are/were concerns for you when implementing Microsoft SharePoint as your document/content repository?




Does your organization plan to grant business users access to corporate documents and content repositories on mobile and tablet devices?






Thinking about how internal business users and how they use collaboration technology, which of the following would you expect to be their preferred tool sets?

#### **Conclusion**

These results point to an increasing demand for collaboration technologies that give users access to information on the move. They also underscore the need for integrated software tools that reduce the level of customization required to implement them.

However, customization and user interface issues are not the only challenges confronting IT departments. They still need to extend document and repository access to mobile devices and the cloud. But unless these collaboration solutions are easy to adopt, users will avoid them and the IT investment in time and technology will be wasted.

The results of this survey clearly show that IT professionals would like to deploy solutions that are integrated, user-friendly and cost-effective. At the same time, they need to keep documents secure as more mobile access points are created. Meeting all these challenges is imperative if workers are to remain productive and efficient while on the move.
